Founded as The Long Island Home for Nervous Invalids in 1882 by a group of private citizens. Today, a comprehensive provider of mental health and geriatric services in our community.

The Long Island Home became a voluntary not-for-profit specialty healthcare system in 1999 and is guided by a Board of Directors who volunteers their leadership, expertise and time.

The Hospital employs over 1,100 individuals both Non-Union and Union Staff.

The Long Island Home is comprised of South Oaks Hospital and Broadlawn Manor Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

South Oaks Hospital has earned the reputation of outstanding provider of behavioral health services and is recognized for crisis management and stabilization for individuals in the most serious phase of their illness/chemical dependency. South Oaks cares for patients ranging from children age 5 years to senior adults. South Oaks Hospital is recognized for their Child and Adolescent Center of Excellence where an experienced staff provides innovative treatment based on a highly effective behavioral modification system to restore balance and stability during important phases of development.

Broadlawn Manor Nursing and Rehabilitation Center provides skilled nursing, Alzheimer's Care, sub-acute and rehabilitation to patients and residents in their 320-bed facility. In September of 2005, Broadlawn Manor's Adult Day Health Center celebrated their 10th Anniversary. The Adult Day Health Care program supports disabled adults and senior adults while maintaining their residence in the community.

Project Care and Corporate Care offers a non-traditional approach to experiential learning through adventure opportunities by choice fostering self-esteem, communication, problem solving, personal growth and team building. Summer Youth Adventure Weeks are provided annually and local business and corporations utilize the Corporate Care approach by providing adventure workshops, facilitating groups to work/think/learn together.
