rehabilitation. Our state-of-the art
rehabilitation suite offers the latest in
equipment and innovative approaches
maximizing independence and wellness.

pharmacists, social workers,

occupational, recreational
and speech therapists
collaborate to meet the

Sub-Acute Care

The Sub-Acute Care program at Broadlawn Manor is provided to individuals following a



hospitalization when a patient no longer requires an acute setting but is not ready to return home. Patients admitted for sub-acute care benefit

from our interdisciplinary team of healthcare professionals who have a high level of expertise to manage a broad spectrum of diagnoses encompassing complex medical and post-surgical needs that may include pneumonia, wound care management, coronary by-pass surgery, cardio-thoracic surgery, pain management, vascular surgery, tracheotomies, as well as intravenous and respiratory therapies.

Rehabilitation

Our Rehabilitation Program is designed to meet the needs of our patients in a comfortable, functional and therapeutic setting affording each individual state-of-the-art equipment and expertise to achieve maximum potential and excellent outcomes during a short length of stay. Individuals affected by stroke, fractures, joint replacements, amputations, and neurological conditions benefit from additional rehabilitation following their acute hospitalization. The focus of our experienced staff is to promote independence through a variety of rehabilitation therapies and treatments while providing education, motivation and support to attain a peak level of functioning for discharge.

Occupational Therapy

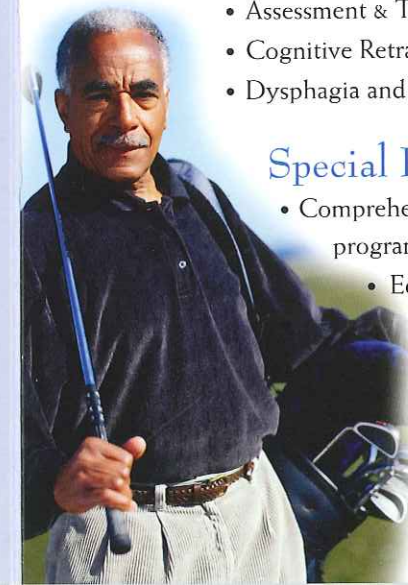

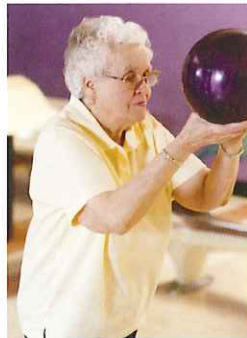

Discharge Planning

Our experienced social work staff works closely with the patient and family acting as a liaison and patient advocate. Initial assessments encompassing medical, social and emotional needs become part of the integrated care plan designed for each patient. Patients and families are invited to actively participate in the care plan, which is monitored for progress and adjusted to meet the needs of the individual patient and maximize recovery. Discharge planning meetings are held focusing on return to the community, coordination of outpatient services, community resources, government entitlements and durable medical equipment needs if necessary.

To qualify for admissions into our Sub-Acute/Rehabilitation Programs applicants must be a minimum of 18 years old and require specialized services as demonstrated by their patient review instrument (PRI), screen and physician recommendation. Patients admitted into specialized service programs benefit by short-term medical management and/or rehabilitation programs to achieve maximum independence, recovery and return to home/community setting.

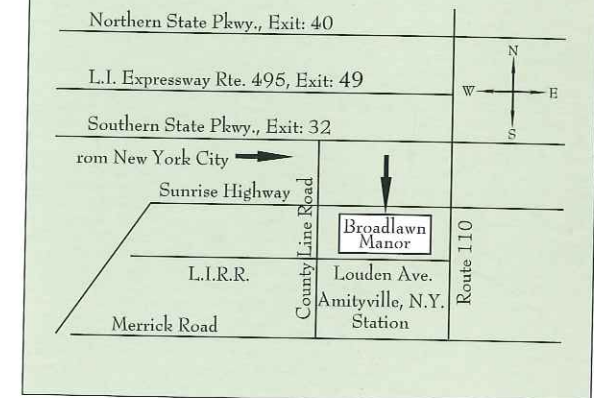
