

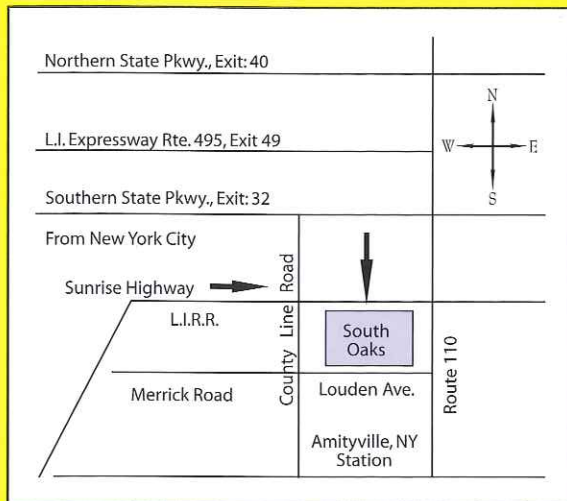

CHILDREN'S

Inpatient Program

The Children's Inpatient Program is designed for children ages 5 through 12 who manifest symptoms of serious behavioral and/or emotional illness.

The program is based on a behavioral system which provides structure within a therapeutic environment. The program emphasizes personal and community responsibility, character, education, individualized goal setting and the performance of alternative coping skills within a supportive milieu.

Comprehensive child and family assessments guide treatment planning and the continuation of care following an inpatient stay.

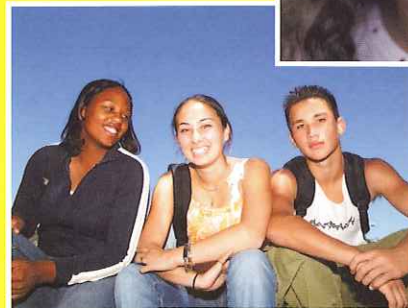
Most major insurance plans, including Medicaid and managed Medicaid accepted.

Programs Include

- Comprehensive psychiatric assessment
- Comprehensive physical exam
- Individual treatment plan
- Education through BOCES
- Interdisciplinary team of child and adolescent psychiatrists, nurses, social workers, psychiatric attendants, certified alcohol and substance abuse counselors, dietitians, pharmacists, occupational, recreational, music and art therapists.
- Programs and groups focusing on family interventions including patient/family therapy sessions.
- Ongoing communication for the most effective discharge planning, focused on continuing treatment needs and community support for patients and families.
- Substance abuse treatment.



ADOLESCENT

Inpatient & Partial Hospital Programs

The Adolescent Inpatient Program is designed for individuals ages 13 through 18 who present primary symptoms of psychiatric disorders and emotional illness.

Programs for adolescents consist of three distinct specialized units providing accommodation for males, females and a co-educational population based upon an individual assessment. Trauma informed care provides a coercion-free environment utilizing evidenced based sensory and cognitive behavioral interventions. Individuals and family assessments guide treatment planning and the continuation of care. Our uniquely designed Calming Room provides an innovative sensory experience to develop individual coping skills and facilitate emotional self regulation.

The Partial Hospitalization Program is designed for individuals ages 13 through 18 who are in school and in need of intensive psychiatric treatment. A structured, supportive environment is provided for those who are able to live in the community and who do not require inpatient hospitalization.

The program operates Monday-Friday from 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM. Transportation is provided within catchment area.
